Synopsis

Portrait of the Egyptian filmmaker Taufiq Salih who struggled to make important Arabic films between the 50's and the 70's with a powerful social and political dimension. He was part of the new generation of directors with Shaheen and Abu Seif who worked on realistic films. Two of his major films are: "The Rebels" (1966) and "The Duped" (1972) which was produced in Syria and was one of the first Arab films to give quite a remarkable approach of the Palestinian question.
